The GDP is the value of all goods and services produced in one year, calculated by output, income or expenditure.



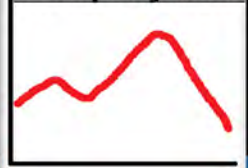
VAT affects us every time we go shopping

Maths is used monitoring environmental impacts of waste, waste processing, and the use of resources along with weighing up the cost effectiveness of methods of disposal.

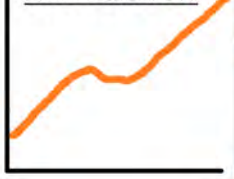


Applied mathematics in physics calculates energy produced by power stations compared to the the relative usage of the population
